



Railing Installation with StoneDeks System

There are 3 common methods to install railing on a deck.

- 1.) Attach railing to the posts that support the deck.
- 2.) Install a top mount railing.
- 3.) Install a fascia mount railing.

All installations of the deck railing systems should be done according to the local building code and the manufacturer's instructions for the system that you are using.

Method 1.) Attach railing to wood deck posts.

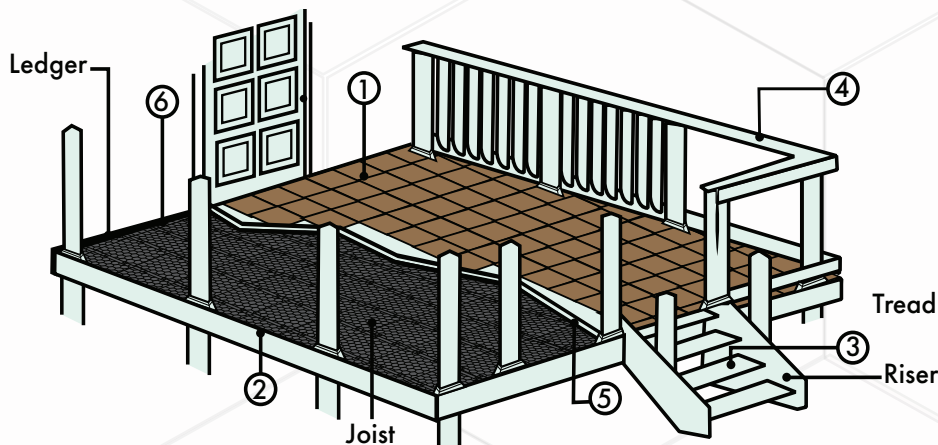
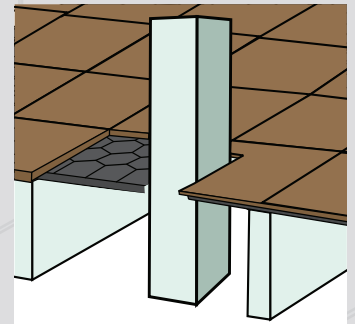
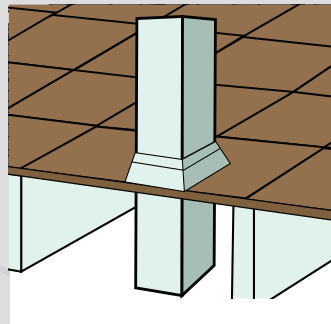


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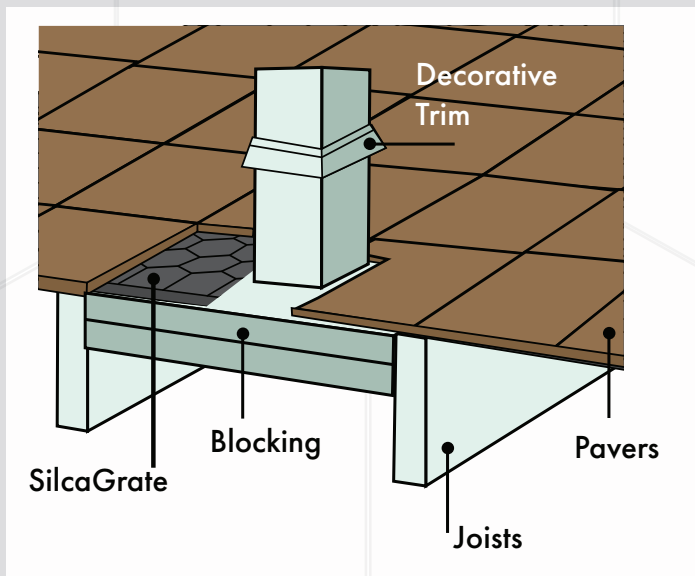
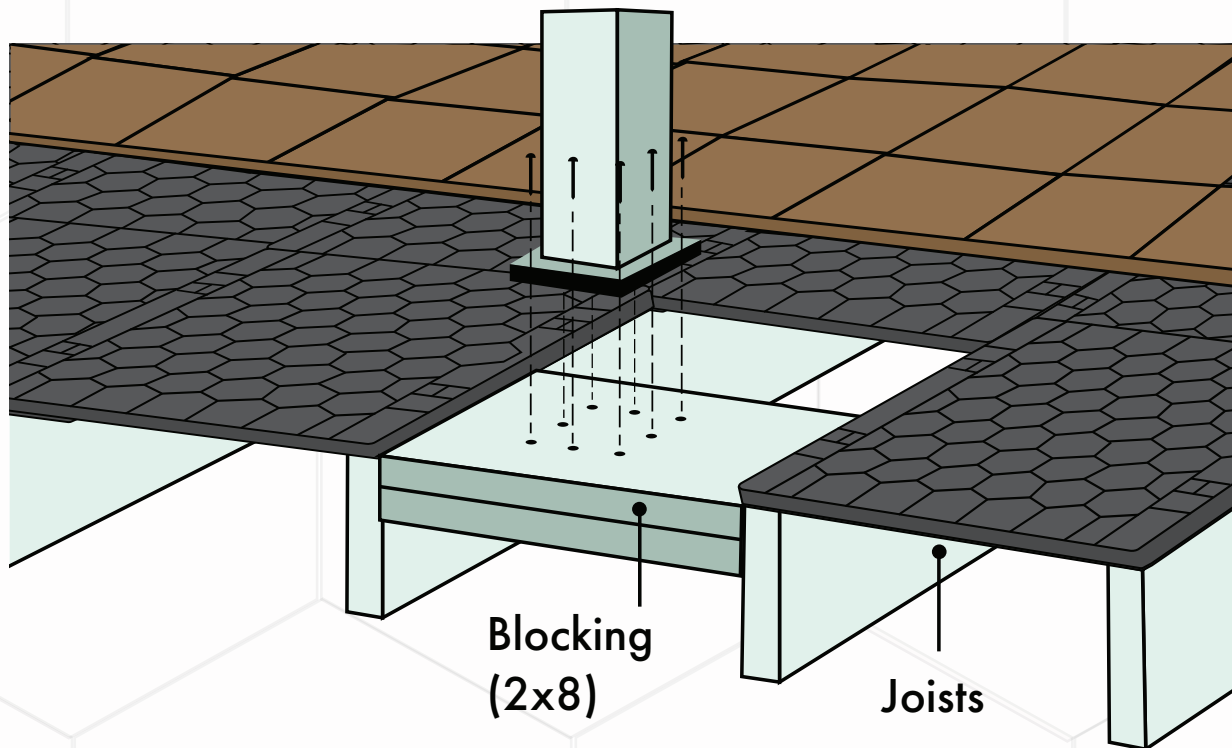
1. Decking
2. Fascia
3. Step
4. Handrail
5. Stringer
6. Deck & Joist Tape

Install railing according to local building code and manufacturer's instructions. Cut SilcaGrates and pavers to wrap around the posts and finish with a decorative trim piece. Wherever SilcaGrates are cut they should be supported with framing or blocking.

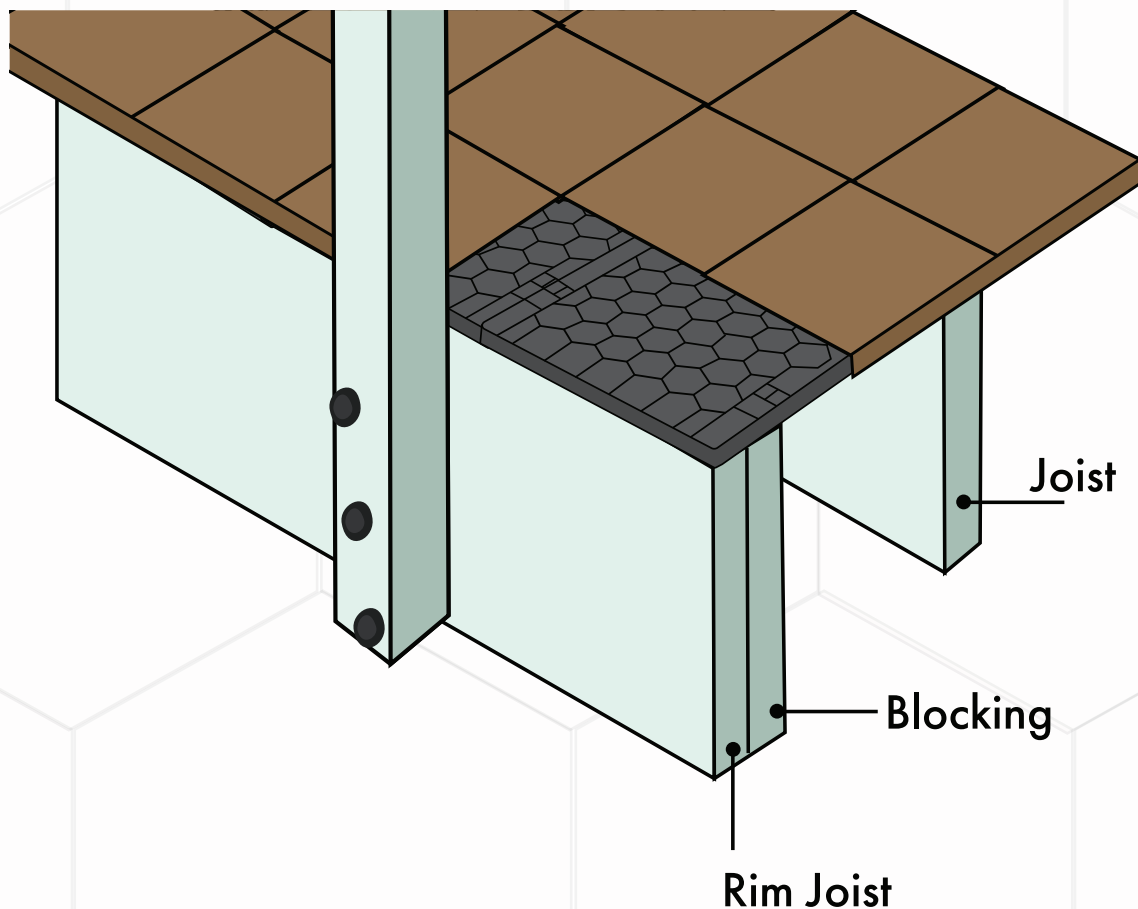
Method 2.) Top Mount Railing Systems



Install railing according to local building code and manufacturer's instructions. Cut SilcaGrates and pavers to wrap around posts and finish with a decorative trim piece. Wherever SilcaGrates are cut they should be supported with framing or blocking.

Railing Installation with StoneDecks System

Method 3.) Fascia Mounted Railing Systems



Install railing according to local building code and manufacturer's instructions. SilcaGrates and pavers can be butted up to the post, or if bullnosing the pavers they can be cut to wrap around the posts. Finish with a decorative trim piece. Wherever SilcaGrates are cut they should be supported with framing or blocking.
